CHEM 115A & B: General Chemistry CHEM 335A: Organic Chemistry  Math  MATH 165: Statistics	Experience Almost all MPA programs require shadowing of a PA and a substantial (minimum of 500 hours) amount of direct "hands on" health care experience. Most competitive applicant have a minimum of 2,000 hours.
All courses should have been completed in the past 5 years with a C- or better. Some programs require a B- or better. Additionally, most MPA programs require a minimum overall and science GPA of 3.0 to be considered.	This experience can be gained through a variety of work such as: EMT, paramedic, certified nursing assistant (CNA), phlebotomist, scribe, registered nurse, medic, etc.

## **ADDITIONAL NOTES**:

MPA programs are quite varied with respects to their prerequisites. The courses above are based on the prerequisites for the MPA program at Samuel Merritt University in Oakland, CA (only as an example). Be sure to look up the specific programs to which you intend to apply.

Most MPA programs do not require a standardized exam (such as the GRE) to apply, but some do recommend it.
