

Economics Teach-Out Advising Plan

Introduction

The Economics major and minor are being discontinued. Upper division economics (ECON) classes will not be offered at SSU after Spring 2027, with most courses only offered during the 2025-2026 academic year. ECON majors must take SSU ECON courses during the 2025-2026 or 2026-27 academic year. If you have other requirements, they can be completed beyond the 2026-2027 academic year. Economics majors will be given *priority registration* for Fall 2025 and Spring 2026. Review your ARR before registration begins. If you have questions about what you need to take, please meet with your advisor early.
